2. It must be completed in one sitting - you may not resume a partially completed application once you exit the browser.
3. Paper copies of the application will not be accepted.
4. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed under any circumstances.

We highly encourage applicants to print out the PDF version of the application from the Teen Career Connection website and prepare typed answers prior to starting the online application (see under 'Apply' tab).

*Please note that submitting multiple applications may affect your candidacy.
